Hilda helped organize Remembrance Day Ceremonies ensuring the veterans felt welcome and were well fed following the ceremony. On Graduation Day for the Grade 7's, Hilda ensured each student felt special and she shared words of encouragement and wisdom with them for the next chapter of their educational journey. She loved to dress up for Halloween and have laughs with the kids. Hilda worked with many parents that attended New Hazelton Elementary School as students and then worked with their children.
